Payment:

All players must register to be considered.

Due to the current situation with the Covid-19 virus and the uncertainty that comes with it, the payment link will open on 23rd April 2021. Once the payment link opens, payments must be completed by no later than 14th May 2021. Any top 16 player who has not completed the payment process by this stage will be considered to have refused invitation to join the team and their position will be offered to a Development Squad Player.

Payment Option:

Payment is to be made through our online payment system. When the link is released it will allow you to make payment as well as enter sizing for playing gear and any additional merchandise you may require.

Important:

- Registration is not transferable to another event
- Non-attendance does not qualify for a refund
- An injured player may be eligible for a registration refund if a replacement player is found.
Note: Uniform fees will not be refunded – however, you will still receive your uniform
- Non-attendance due to suspension will not entitle you to a refund regardless of timing to the event
- Development Squad Players will receive a registration refund if they are not brought into the team. Any gear ordered will be provided.
